- 50. Hundred Acre Kayli Morgan Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Napa Valley \$510**
The 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon Kayli Morgan Vineyard has a medium garnet-purple color and is a little closed to begin, giving up red and black currants, violets, lilacs and spice box plus chocolate covered coffee beans, menthol, tilled soil and cardamom. The palate is full-bodied, concentrated and built like a brick house, with loads of floral sparks and a very long, mineral-laced finish.
- 51. Joseph Phelps Insignia BDX Blend 2015, Napa Valley \$300**
The 2015 Insignia is densely hued with rich dark fruit, cocoa powder and fragrant dried flower notes. Velvety texture and weight on the palate with layers of juicy black plum, Madagascar vanilla and bergamot. Bold, creamy and supple with integrated tannin structure and a lengthy finish. Blend: 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Petit Verdot, 2% Cabernet Franc, 1% Malbec
- 52. Sinegal Estate Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, St. Helena, Napa \$275**
The 2016 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon is a blockbuster of a wine, opening with explosive aromas of crushed red currants, Chambord, and black tea leaf; enveloped in layers of sweet cigar box and cocoa beans. The full-bodied palate displays flavors of macerated blackberries and blueberries with hints of graphite and dried herbs, leading to a dense tannin structure and long and bright finish. Blend: 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Malbec, 7% Petit Verdot
- 53. Staglin Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Rutherford, Napa Valley \$260**
Invitingly warm, resinous and flirting with extremes, the decadent 2015 Staglin Cabernet is a brûléed, dark fruited marvel that thrills with its texture and layers. A mousse-like quality brings a breath of air and light to the dense, concentrated mouthfeel and softens the abundant underlying tannins that provide a pleasant grip to a powdery, fine-grained mineral driven exit. Blend: 88% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Cabernet Franc, 4% Petit Verdot.
- 54. Hall, Kathryn Hall Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley \$195**
The 2016 Kathryn Hall is deep ruby in color with enticing aromas of cassis, violets, cacao, anise and black tea. This powerful vintage sets the stage for a full-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon with layered notes of dark plum, ripe blackberry, anise, pine needle and violet. The firm tannins are well integrated and provide a structured backbone to this opulent wine. Blend: 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot

- 55. DAOU Vineyards Soul of a Lion 2017, BDX, Adelaida District** **\$160**
The 2017 vintage displays richness, elegance and balance. A deep, complex bouquet reveals notes of cassis, black currant, licorice, incense, ripe plum and vanilla. The palate is full-bodied, layered and complex, while smooth, silky tannins lead to a persistent finish.
- 56. Silver Oak Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Napa Valley** **\$135**
The 2015 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is a robust wine with an assertive and alluring attack. It has notes of strawberry, cigar and tea leaves with a touch of black pepper and clove. A mouthwatering mid-palate of raspberry is followed by an expressive and bright finish. Blend: 81% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12.6% Merlot, 3.6% Cabernet Franc, 2.4% Petit Verdot, 0.4% Malbec.
- 57. Orin Swift Cellars Mercury Head Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa** **\$130**
Aromatics of ripe raspberry, blackcurrant, cigar box and a hint of fresh sandalwood shavings and Herbs de Provence – mysteriously intriguing at first but evolving into a thoroughbred with time and air. Dense and layered on the palate, an immediate note of mixed berry strudel topped with fresh cream, fresh black raspberry and soft tannins akin to baking chocolate transition to a finish of both nuance and concentration.
- 58. Darioush Signature Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley** **\$130**
The hallmark of Darioush Signature Cabernet Sauvignon is its seamlessness, the result of decades of meticulous vineyard management of the cooler climate, Southern Napa Valley sites. Darioush estate vineyards in the Mount Veeder and Napa Valley AVA's have hit their stride, producing fruit with splendid concentration, compelling freshness, and graceful complexity. The final composition strikes a tightrope balance of youthful energy, structure, and restraint; the flagship wine rewards with extraordinary depth and poise.
- 59. Quilt Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Napa Valley** **\$120**
A full-bodied wine with layers of complexity, concentrated black fruit and excellent balance. Aromas of dark currant, chocolate hazelnut cream, coffee beans, dark fruit, vanilla, red plum and roasted meats pay homage to bold and intense flavors of blackberry cobbler, crème de cassis, chocolate, toffee and strawberry. The wine's bold structure is complemented by a supple, velvety mouthfeel.

7. **Kosta Browne Pinot Noir 2017, Russian River Valley** **\$100**
Bright citrus rind with fresh cranberry, strawberry and a touch of baking spice. Broad, with a supportive acid structure which highlights the notes of raspberry, pomegranate and well-balanced oak.
33. **PlumpJack Merlot 2018, Oak Knoll Napa Valley** **\$85**
Black cherry, boysenberry jam, plum, and fresh cut flowers. Cardamom, nutmeg, cocoa and vanilla. Red cherries, muddled berries, and dried herbs. Creamy and silky tannins with a fresh, vibrant acidity.
36. **Faust Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley** **\$60**
Intense yet fresh with juicy blue and black notes. Notes of dark chocolate and dried herbs seduce the palate while silky tannins and lifting acidity lead to a layered and lingering finish.
11. **Quilt Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley** **\$44**
Crème de cassis, hazelnut, cocoa, blackberry preserves, a cherry meat toastiness, dark fruits, and blackberry pie along with suggestions of dark licorice, stewed rhubarb, strawberry, spice, and vanillin.
15. **Orin Swift Cellars Machete Petite Sirah 2017, California** **\$55**
Plum compote, wild blackberries, crushed gravel, peanut brittle and Tahitian vanilla emanate. Dark plums, black pepper, Amarena cherries, slow-roasted Moroccan lamb and a marbled leather texture.
21. **Orin Swift Cellars Slander Pinot Noir 2017, California** **\$55**
Ripe cherries and dried rose petals, white pepper and alpine forest. Strawberries, cranberries, and rhubarb on the palate. A finish of toasted brioche, a dash of caramel and fresh raspberries.
43. **Duckhorn Merlot 2017, Napa Valley (375ml)** **\$35**
Aromas of lush cherry, raspberry, cocoa and freshly baked pie crust. Cherry and raspberry notes on a silky palate. Fine-grained tannins and flavors of ripe plum, blueberry, licorice and subtle baking spice

74. **Bouchard Pere & Fils Chassagne-Montrachet 2017, Burgundy** \$85
Intense floral and fruit aromas on the nose. Full-bodied, rich and smooth, with a lingering aftertaste.
77. **Kosta Browne One Sixteen Chardonnay 2018, Russian River** \$85
Pure, with bright lemon zest, honeysuckle, cantaloupe and notes of brioche. Precise and intentional entry with a lively energetic mid-palate, focused acidity and a round, nimble weight.
78. **Rochioli Estate Chardonnay 2018, Russian River** \$65
This straw-yellow wine has a concentrated aroma of Ripe apple, apricot, vanilla, and a touch of spice. The rich apple flavors and crisp acidity with a hint of hazelnut for a long, balanced finish.
75. **Chateau Montelena Chardonnay 2017, Napa Valley** \$60
Peach, apricot, and honeydew. Citrus blossom and rose water. Fresh pear and cinnamon. Lemon curd with bright acid, green apple, and toast. with a hint of white pepper and plenty of orange zest.
80. **Orin Swift Cellars Blank Stare Sauvignon Blanc 2018, Russian River** \$37
Lemongrass, fresh-cut grass and hints of lavender, cream, and jasmine. The entry is all acidity with flavors of kiwi, lime, and minerality. The finish is bright and youthful with a slight Meyer lemon rind.
71. **Patient Cottat Anciennes Vignes Sancerre 2018, France** \$35
Lemon with golden-green reflections. Complex and intense aromas of acacia blossoms with a Muscat-like nose of passionfruit. Very well balanced. Notes of litchi and a small touch of honey.
95. **Pascal Jolivet Sancerre 2018, France** \$33
Fresh, clean and screaming with racy acidity. On the palate it is fresh and tightly wound; acidity tempered by very subtle residual sugar; very clean; alive, racy, youthful. Overall, a dry and elegant wine.
98. **Chateau Minuty Prestige Rose 2019, France** \$30
Pale with pomelo lights. Precise and delicate with notes of flowers and melon, citrus and red fruits. Underlined by a pleasant minerality. Blend: 60% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 10% Cinsault, 10% Tibouren
79. **Hall Sauvignon Blanc 2018, Napa Valley** \$28
Gooseberry, fresh cut grass, juicy mango, lemon rind, and grapefruit. Dry with crisp acidity and a palate of pineapple, lemon, lime, minerality, and rich creaminess developed by stirring the lees in tank.
72. **Long Shadows Poet's Leap Riesling 2018, Columbia Valley** \$25
Juicy kumquat and lively grapefruit laced with hints of white peach and honey with a pleasing minerality throughout. Beautifully balanced with racy acidity, the off-dry finish is long and clean.
92. **Elouan Rosé 2019, Oregon** \$20
Intense fruit flavor, structure, and vibrant acidity. A bespoke rosé with crisp, clean aromas and tastes. A great choice for outdoor occasions: picnics, lunch on the patio, or enjoyed on its own as an aperitif.

8. **Caymus Cabernet Sauvignon 2018, Napa Valley (1L)** \$110
Layered, lush aromas and flavors, including cocoa, cassis, and ripe dark berries. Featuring decadent ripe blackberry flavors with undertones of vanilla and toasted oak.
6. **Caymus Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley (750ml)** \$93
Layered, lush aromas and flavors, including cocoa, cassis, and ripe dark berries. Featuring decadent ripe blackberry flavors with undertones of vanilla and toasted oak.
2. **Caymus Suisun Grand Durif 2017, Suisun Valley** \$65
With lush textural tannins, this wine is rich, supple and totally enjoyable. The nose has notes of blueberries and earthy tones, while vanilla notes from oak aging come through on the finish.
13. **Red Schooner Voyage 8 by Caymus Malbec, Argentina/Napa Valley** \$44
Opens with a warm, alluring nose. Lush plums and grippy tannins. An earthy character of leather and cooking over an open fire carries through to the long finish, whose fruit tapers off to toasted wood.

3. **Emmolo Merlot 2017, Napa Valley** \$58
Bold and luscious flavors of ripe cherries, earth, smoke, and figs. Full-bodied and soft, the finish is laced with delicately smooth tannins that give the wine a silky texture.
89. **Emmolo Methode Traditionelle Sparkling Wine No. 2, California** \$40
Produced on Méthode Traditionelle. Features soft bubbles and freshness that yields to creaminess from extended aging. Blend: 56% Chardonnay, 44% Pinot Noir
84. **Emmolo Sauvignon Blanc 2017, Napa Valley** \$25
Scents of white peach and guava. On the palate an acidity balanced by flavors of peach and honeydew. A tart, smooth texture that lingers in the mouth. The mouth-watering finish is unusually bright and crisp.

Mer Soleil – Santa Lucia Highlands

10. **Mer Soleil Reserve Pinot Noir 2017, Santa Lucia Highlands** \$35
Scents of ripe cherries with cocoa, pomace, blueberry, toasted wood and a whiff of old-fashioned lipstick. Cherry cobbler mingle with cola notes and hints of anise. A wisp of acidity adds balance and freshness.

- 57. Orin Swift Cellars Mercury Head Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa** **\$130**
Aromatics of ripe raspberry, blackcurrant, cigar box and a hint of fresh sandalwood shavings and Herbs de Provence – mysteriously intriguing at first but evolving into a thoroughbred with time and air. Dense and layered on the palate, an immediate note of mixed berry strudel topped with fresh cream, fresh black raspberry and soft tannins akin to baking chocolate transition to a finish of both nuance and concentration.
- 17. Orin Swift Cellars Papillon BDX Blend 2017, Napa Valley** **\$70**
Powerful aromatics escape the glass with rich notes of ripe blackcurrant, blackberry, peppercorn and a touch of chaparral supported by a frame of sweet oak. Intensely layered and decadent on entry, the wine exudes characteristics of black plum, boysenberry, kirsch and dark chocolate with a silky soft yet weighty texture. A prolonged finish of Provençal lavender, fig leaf and ripe currants close out the wine.
- 19. Orin Swift Cellars Palermo Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley** **\$57**
A seamless assortment of classic Napa Cabernet aromas exude from the glass – cassis, black cherries, chaparral and a touch of intriguing butterscotch. On the palate, the wine is tastefully expressive with ripe raspberry, crème caramel, bay leaf and two types of currants – red and black.
- 15. Orin Swift Cellars Machete Petite Sirah 2017, California** **\$55**
A gothic mauve with a vivid neon rim, the wine appears almost black in the glass. Notes of wet stone, black plum and crushed gravel reverberate from within. Bold upfront, the palate is all-enveloping with mixed berry crepe, black licorice and a touch of char. Layered and omnipotent in weight, the wine finishes with ripe Petite Sirah tannins, providing a pleasant closing texture.
- 21. Orin Swift Cellars Slander Pinot Noir 2017, California** **\$55**
Abundantly aromatic, the wine opens with ripe cranberry, marmalade, white pepper, fresh brioche, dried sage, camphor and Mediterranean coastal trail. The entry is silky with a flood of bing cherry galette, Madagascar vanilla and ripe red fruits. Seamless, integrated and elegantly opulent, the wine finishes gracefully with trace amounts of soft, oak tannin.
- 28. Orin Swift Cellars 8 Years in the Desert 2 Zinfandel 2018, California** **\$50**
An opaque core with a red amethyst rim, opening with ripe raspberry and blackberry, dark plum preserves, and hints of black pepper and clove. The palate is packed with blueberry and sweet black cherry with a touch of fresh herbs - thyme, savory, and tarragon. Long on the finish, the ripe tannins, a dash of ash, and notes of black tea round out the wine.
- 29. Orin Swift Cellars Abstract 2018, California** **\$40**
Aromatics with gravity, the wine pulls you in with notes of blueberry, black fig, bloodied strawberry and hints of musk and rhubarb. Bold on the entry, the palate exudes rich notes of dark plum and ripe framboise with a slightly chalky texture. The wine transitions effortlessly to a finish of black cherry, sweet licorice and some quick drying tannins.

- 73. Orin Swift Cellars Mannequin Chardonnay 2017, California** **\$39**
A lurid straw gold, the aromatics abound with bright lemon, butterscotch, honeysuckle and jasmine, with hints of Granny Smith apple, fresh butter and lime zest. Rich and layered upon entry, the palate espouses honeydew, yellow peach, vanilla with a lush, weighty viscosity. A vein of acidity is present through the finish with a pleasing close of minerality and lemon pith.
- 80. Orin Swift Cellars Blank Stare Sauvignon Blanc 2018, Russian River** **\$37**
A glowing pale straw with a striking touch of chartreuse sits in the glass. Aromatically, the wine pops with lime zest, gooseberries, ripe passionfruit, fresh cut grass and lemon bars. On the entry, the acidity acts like a belt, constraining the voluptuousness; similar taste profiles to the nose plus crispy green apples and the faintest hint of fresh sage abound. The finish is reminiscent of ripe kiwi and limoncello, teetering on a beam of lingering acidity.
- 44. Locations by Dave Phinney E-6 Red, Spain** **\$25**
The wine presents a dark, polished amethyst with aromatic notes of white pepper, tobacco, and black currant emerging from the glass. A silky mouthfeel with a palate of dark plums, black raspberry, and hints of French vanilla closes with subtle tart black cherry and a lengthy finish.
- 45. Locations by Dave Phinney F-6 Red, France** **\$25**
A dominant nose of raspberry, rhubarb, and wild strawberry are complemented by savory aromas of humid tobacco, lavender and rose petal. An immediate entry of cranberry and other red fruit leads to a touch of savoriness. The wine is fresh and lively with great acidity and approachable tannins.
- 46. Locations by Dave Phinney I-7 Red, Italy** **\$25**
A vast array of aromas escape the glass - black cherry, nutmeg, cinnamon, and cured meat - which are complemented by shades of sandalwood, vanilla, balsa and evergreen. e entry is silky smooth with a textured mid-palate of velvety fig, blueberry jam and soft oak. A hint of sea salt on the finish is rounded out with a mouthfeel that fades slowly.

I created Locations based on a simple concept – make the best possible wine from a given country or location. This simple concept ended up being pretty challenging to put into action. I travelled the world, explaining my concept to some of the worlds’ finest vineyard owners, eventually turning skeptics into believers, and secured some of the best fruit to make the Locations wines. In the process of creating Locations, I’ve had a lot of fun, visiting incredible vineyard sites and meeting amazing people, while challenging each other to make the best wine possible.

Throughout the world of wine there are distinct and highly prized geographical areas where soil and climate interact to produce grapes that uniquely express their sense of place through wine. These prized vineyard areas are situated within appellations of the old (primarily Europe) and new (mostly the rest of the world) world but are rarely combined in the art of blending, due to local laws and restrictions. These local laws and restrictions make it almost impossible to express true winemaking freedom.

I seek out high-quality vineyards, and forward-thinking growers, across appellations to create a wine that proudly represents the best viticultural parcels of that country or location. Our quest is for old vines with low yields, to bring out the best of a specific vineyard and area. We then combine these parcels of place to craft a wine that pays homage to the country of origin; a wine that makes all of us proud.

6. **Caymus Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley** **\$93**
Layered, lush aromas and flavors, including cocoa, cassis, and ripe dark berries. Featuring decadent ripe blackberry flavors with undertones of vanilla and toasted oak.
47. **Duckhorn Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley** **\$78**
Blackberry, huckleberry and chocolate. Mint, cardamom, clove and graham cracker. Boysenberry and black currant. Blend: 87% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12% Merlot, 0.5% Cabernet Franc, 0.5% Petit Verdot
20. **Reynolds Family Winery Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley** **\$65**
Black cherry, star anise and subtleties of cedar, leather and candied red fruits. The flavors weave together on the palate with ripe blackberries and warm baking spices to create an elegant mouthfeel.
36. **Faust Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley** **\$60**
Intense yet fresh with juicy blue and black notes. Notes of dark chocolate and dried herbs seduce the palate while silky tannins and lifting acidity lead to a layered and lingering finish.
1. **TPW Co. Cuttings Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley** **\$60**
Flavors of blueberry, dark cherry, and cocoa. Aromas of fresh roasted coffee, black currant, vanilla bean, brown spice, and wild berries. 80% Cabernet Sauvignon; 20% Blend of Petite Sirah, Syrah, and Zin.
4. **Frank Family Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley** **\$60**
Seamlessly woven in black cherry and cocoa, seductive in structure and complexity. The palate offers flavors of hazelnut, baked plum, and cloves while brilliant acidity balances the flavors and tannins.
19. **Orin Swift Cellars Palermo Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley** **\$57**
