- 201. Hundred Acre Kayli Morgan Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Napa Val.** ⁽¹⁰⁰⁾ **\$510**
The 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon Kayli Morgan Vineyard has a medium garnet-purple color and is a little closed to begin, giving up red and black currants, violets, lilacs and spice box plus chocolate covered coffee beans, menthol, tilled soil and cardamom. The palate is full-bodied, concentrated and built like a brick house, with loads of floral sparks and a very long, mineral-laced finish.
- 202. Joseph Phelps Insignia BDX Blend 2015, Napa Valley** ⁽⁹⁹⁾ **\$300**
The 2015 Insignia is densely hued with rich dark fruit, cocoa powder and fragrant dried flower notes. Velvety texture and weight on the palate with layers of juicy black plum, Madagascar vanilla and bergamot. Bold, creamy and supple with integrated tannin structure and a lengthy finish. Blend: 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Petit Verdot, 2% Cabernet Franc, 1% Malbec
- 203. Sinegal Estate Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, St. Helena, Napa** ⁽⁹⁹⁾ **\$275**
Aromas of crushed red currants, Chambord, and black tea leaf; enveloped in layers of sweet cigar box and cocoa beans. The full-bodied palate displays flavors of macerated blackberries and blueberries with hints of graphite and dried herbs, leading to a dense tannin structure and long and bright finish. Blend: 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Malbec, 7% Petit Verdot
- 204. Staglin Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Rutherford, Napa Valley** ⁽⁹⁸⁾ **\$260**
A brûléed, dark fruited marvel that thrills with its texture and layers. A mousse-like quality brings a breath of air and light to the dense, concentrated mouthfeel and softens the abundant underlying tannins that provide a pleasant grip to a powdery, fine-grained mineral driven exit. Blend: 88% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Cabernet Franc, 4% Petit Verdot
- 205. Hall, Kathryn Hall Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley** ⁽⁹⁷⁾ **\$195**
The 2016 Kathryn Hall is deep ruby in color with enticing aromas of cassis, violets, cacao, anise and black tea. This powerful vintage sets the stage for a full-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon with layered notes of dark plum, ripe blackberry, anise, pine needle and violet. The firm tannins are well integrated and provide a structured backbone to this opulent wine. Blend: 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot
- 206a. DAOU Vineyards Soul of a Lion 2017, Adelaida District (750ml)** ⁽⁹⁷⁾ **\$160**
Deep ruby-purple in color and wonderfully unique expression, with scents of forest floor, underbrush, English breakfast tea, espresso, blackcurrant bud, dark chocolate and exotic flowers mingling over a core of perfectly ripe wild blackberries and Morello cherries, all complemented by a classy framing of new oak spices. Blend: 80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12% Cabernet Franc and 8% Petit Verdot
- 206b. DAOU Vineyards Soul of a Lion 2017, Adelaida District (375ml)** ⁽⁹⁷⁾ **\$80**
Deep ruby-purple in color and wonderfully unique expression, with scents of forest floor, underbrush, English breakfast tea, espresso, blackcurrant bud, dark chocolate and exotic flowers mingling over a core of perfectly ripe wild blackberries and Morello cherries, all complemented by a classy framing of new oak spices. Blend: 80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12% Cabernet Franc and 8% Petit Verdot

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- 207. Silver Oak Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Napa Valley** ⁽⁹⁴⁾ **\$135**
The 2015 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon is a robust wine with an assertive and alluring attack. It has notes of strawberry, cigar and tea leaves with a touch of black pepper and clove. A mouthwatering mid-palate of raspberry is followed by an expressive and bright finish. Blend: 81% Cabernet Sauvignon, 12.6% Merlot, 3.6% Cabernet Franc, 2.4% Petit Verdot, 0.4% Malbec.
- 208. Orin Swift Cellars Mercury Head Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa** ⁽⁹⁵⁾ **\$130**
Aromatics of ripe raspberry, blackcurrant, cigar box and a hint of fresh sandalwood shavings and Herbs de Provence – mysteriously intriguing at first but evolving into a thoroughbred with time and air. Dense and layered on the palate, an immediate note of mixed berry strudel topped with fresh cream, fresh black raspberry and soft tannins akin to baking chocolate transition to a finish of both nuance and concentration.
- 209a. Darioush Signature Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley** ⁽⁹²⁾ **\$130**
Deep purple black colored, notions of warm cassis, blueberry preserves and boysenberries with touches of cedar chest, cherry cola and spice cake. Full-bodied, the palate has a firm, grainy texture and a lively line carrying the spicy black berry preserves flavors to a nice long finish..
- 210. Quilt Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Napa Valley** **\$120**
A full-bodied wine with layers of complexity, concentrated black fruit and excellent balance. Aromas of dark currant, chocolate hazelnut cream, coffee beans, dark fruit, vanilla, red plum and roasted meats pay homage to bold and intense flavors of blackberry cobbler, crème de cassis, chocolate, toffee and strawberry. The wine's bold structure is complemented by a supple, velvety mouthfeel.
- 211. Dalla Valle Maya Proprietary Red Blend 2015, Oakville** ⁽¹⁰⁰⁾ **\$580**
The 2015 Maya shows the great potential of the vintage. Its red-purple hue belies the wine's brightness and fresh aromatic quality, with tones of fresh-cut strawberry, cardamom, and flint. This blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc exhibits a combination of depth, richness, and laser-like focus, delivering a rush of red and black fruit flavors, along with notes of cured meats and salted black licorice. The texture is soft and silky, but at the same time powerful and incredibly lengthy.
- 212. Dalla Valle Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley** ⁽⁹⁷⁾ **\$260**
Dark and showy, with a degree of aromatic complexity and effusiveness. Immediately upon decanting, the room is filled with fruit and floral aromas—fresh-cut cherries, blackberries, blueberry pie, and orange blossom—along with earthier elements of dark roast coffee, wet slate, and underbrush. A powerful, long, and tightly woven palate, delivering waves of flavor and texture that linger for nearly a full minute.
- 213. Dalla Valle Collina BDX Blend 2016, Napa Valley** ⁽⁹³⁾ **\$110**
The 2016 Collina Dalla Valle is rich and pliant, not to mention insanely delicious. Graphite, spice, cedar and red plum overtones infuse the 2016 with striking complexity and layers of dimension. The Collina is a gorgeous and expressive wine, one of the very best deals in high-end, artisanal Cabernet.

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- 214. Lokoya Howell Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley** ⁽⁹⁸⁾ **\$475**
The 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon Howell Mountain (100% Cabernet Sauvignon) is deep purple-black in color and offers an incredible perfume of lilacs, black truffles, violets and menthol over a core of cassis, mulberries and warm plums plus a waft of tobacco leaf. The palate is full-bodied with very firm, very ripe tannins and oodles of freshness cutting through the earthy layers, finishing very long.
- 215. Lokoya Spring Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley** ⁽⁹⁹⁾ **\$475**
Deep garnet-purple (100% Cabernet Sauvignon.) the 2016 Spring Mountain gives up notes of licorice, chocolate box and spearmint over a core of crushed blackcurrants, blackberries and kirsch plus wafts of roses and fertile loam. Full-bodied, firm and oh-so-minerally in the mouth, a solid structure of grainy tannins and seamless freshness, finishing on a lingering earthy note. 825 cases produced.
- 225. OVID Hexameter BDX Blend 2016, Napa Valley** ⁽⁹⁸⁾ **\$360**
Bold Black Forest cake, cassis and redcurrant jelly scents with candied violets, pencil lead, oolong tea and cumin seed with a touch of cigar box. Medium to full-bodied. Red and black fruit beautifully laced with exotic spices and floral fragrances, framed by super ripe, super fine-grained tannins and fantastic freshness, finishing long. Blend: 55% Cabernet Franc, 44% Cabernet Sauvignon, 1% Merlot
- 216a. PlumpJack Oakville Estate Cabernet 2017, Napa Valley (750ml)** ⁽⁹⁵⁾ **\$160**
Aromas of blackberry, blueberry, and black cherry. Savory spice aromas of sage, clove, and nutmeg compliment the fruit and bring depth and complexity. These flavors carry over to the palate, which has a rich, creamy texture balanced by a crisp, fresh acid. The tannin is bold yet seamless and silky, while the persistent finish gives the impression of blackberries dusted with baker's chocolate.
- 216b. PlumpJack Oakville Estate Cabernet 2016, Napa Valley (375ml)** ⁽⁹⁶⁾ **\$90**
Aromas of blackberry, blueberry, and black cherry. Sage, clove, and nutmeg compliment the fruit and bring depth and complexity. The palate has a rich, creamy texture balanced by a crisp, fresh acid. The tannin is bold yet seamless and silky, while the persistent finish gives the impression of blackberries dusted with baker's chocolate. Blend: 90% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Petit Verdot and 5% Malbec
- 217. PlumpJack Oak Knoll Merlot 2018, Napa Valley** **\$85**
Black cherry, boysenberry jam, plum, and fresh cut flowers come through first, then cardamom, nutmeg, and a touch of cocoa and vanilla enter giving the nose depth and intrigue. The palate too has great depth and complexity – flavors of red cherries, muddled berries, and dried herbs, with a creamy texture and silky tannin complimented by a fresh, vibrant acidity.
- 218a. Quintessa Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Rutherford (750ml)** ⁽⁹⁵⁾ **\$200**
Powerfully structured, with elegant tannins. Aromas of black cherry and cassis coated with dark chocolate. Notes of thyme and sage interplay with hints of cinnamon, cedar, and incense. The wine develops on the palate with lively acidity offering balance to graceful layers of red and black fruit. Savory nuances of tar and tobacco follow, through a long, lingering finish marked by fine tannin.

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- 218b. Quintessa Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Rutherford (375ml) ⁽⁹⁸⁾ \$110**
Aromas of cassis, blackberry, red currant and undertones of sage, thyme, crushed rocks, and rose petals, the 2016 Quintessa continues to expand in the glass as notes of exotic citrus, clove and fresh tobacco mingle with bright fruit. Full and rich, the wine is held together with fine-grained tannins that interweave beautifully with flavors of dark chocolate, crushed rocks, black cherry, and blueberries.
- 219. Ornellaia BDX Blend 2017, Bolgheri, Tuscany ⁽⁹⁷⁾ \$260**
*The Ornellaia 2017 masterfully interprets what was a particularly warm and sunny year. The intense and dark color heralds a wine of beautiful concentration; the nose, rich and complex, releases scents of ripe red fruits, accompanied by notes of sweet tobacco and vanilla.
Blend: 56% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot, 10% Petit Verdot, 9% Cabernet Franc*
- 220. Caymus Special Selection Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley ⁽⁹⁵⁾ \$195**
A blackberry hue, with scents of rich leather, cooked caramel, berries and forest floor. Youthfully forward on the palate, supple and appealing with rich concentration. Tannins are abundant, yet fine, and persist throughout a layering of textural sensation. The richness of this wine correlates with the fine dust of the Napa Valley soils. Finish expresses oak (French barrel) and Caymus fruit-forward impressions. This wine is tannic, rich and squared off by signature, Caymus suppleness.
- 221. Knights Bridge Knights Valley Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Sonoma ⁽⁹⁰⁾ \$120**
This well-proportioned wine abounds with notes of blueberry and mocha with subtle hints of vanilla and spice. The palate has a lush entry filled with dark chocolate, black cherry, and notes of blueberry and vanilla. The mouth-filling finish is chewy and savory with a balanced acidity and silky tannins.
- 222. La Jota Howell Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley ⁽⁹⁷⁾ \$150**
A blend of 77% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Cabernet Franc, 7% Malbec, 5% Merlot and 3% Petit Verdot, this wine is deep garnet-purple colored, featuring gregarious crème de cassis, black cherry preserves and baked plums with touches of Indian spices, cigar box and charcuterie. Full, firm and decadently fruited, it has a fantastic foundation and very long, layered and expressive finish.
- 223. Moone Tsai Howell Mountain Hillside Blend 2015, Napa Valley ⁽⁹⁶⁾ \$125**
Aromas of dark Bing cherry and plum, with hints of vanilla, nutmeg, and coriander. Concentrated flavors of ripe black cherry and black plum, accented by trances of pomegranate, tamarind and baking spices. The wine's silky tannins complemented by a pleasing minerality revealing a pleasing structure that is layered, balanced and bold... closing to a finish characterized by persistence and resolve.
- 224. Moone Tsai Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Coombsville, Napa Valley ⁽⁹³⁾ \$110**
A blend of 88% Cabernet Sauvignon with 12% Merlot aged 20 months in 60% new oak. Very deep garnet-purple colored featuring crème de cassis, dried herbs, aged meat and preserved plums with hints of tobacco and tilled earth. Medium to full-bodied, the palate delivers bags of bright, crunchy black fruits with loads of earthy sparks and a rugged texture, finishing with loads of freshness.

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- 227. Catena Appellation Lunlunta Malbec 2017, Mendoza** ⁽⁹²⁾ **\$30**
Aromas of ripe red and dark fruits with traces of vanilla and mocha. The mouthfeel is rich and concentrated, with blueberries and blackberries notes and a touch of leather and cinnamon. The finish presents well integrated supple tannins with a flinty minerality that gives the wine exceptional length.
- 228. Catena Alta Malbec 2016, Mendoza** ⁽⁹⁴⁾ **\$60**
Made from 100% Malbec. Fermented and aged in 70% new barrels, the 2016 Malbec Historic Rows is an incredibly elegant, seamless wine that has an almost Burgundian style in its mulberry, blueberries, incense, forest floor, and spring flowers. Medium to full body, supple tannins, terrific balance.
- 229. Catena Zapata Nicolás BDX Blend 2015, Mendoza** ⁽⁹⁶⁾ **\$115**
Intense dark violet color with blue-black tones. A complex wine with delicate aromas of black cherry and licorice, it is enlivened by minerals, violet, spice, and herbs. The palate is sharply delineated and impressively concentrated, with a serious backbone supporting its very fresh currant and mineral flavors.
- 230. Catena Zapata Nicasia Vineyard Malbec 2015, Mendoza** ⁽⁹⁷⁾ **\$130**
Catena Zapata Nicasia Vineyard Malbec is a dark violet Malbec. Aromas of ripe black and red currant, raspberries and an elegant touch of French oak. Very complex and expressive palate, with a creamy violet flavor with ripe blueberries, cassis, vanilla and spice-cake.
- 231. Catena Zapata Argentino Vineyard Malbec 2017, Mendoza** ⁽⁹⁷⁾ **\$130**
Lots of blackberry and blueberry aromas with licorice, too. Extremely aromatic. Full-bodied, layered and deep. Superb richness and balance, at the same time. Notes of raspberry that gives brightness to the aromas, and the palate is medium bodied with fine-grained tannins.
- 232. Catena Zapata Adrianna Vin. River Stones Malbec 2015, Uco Val.** ⁽⁹⁶⁾ **\$165**
An intense hot-stone character with limestone and iron. Blackberries and dark tea. White salt, too. Full-bodied, round and juicy. A rich finish. Flamboyant. A rich, spicy, textured wine fermented with 100% stems. Plum and bramble fruit flavors with understated oak and a ripe, figgy finish.
- 233. Catena Zapata Adrianna White Bones Chardonnay 2017, Mendoza** ⁽⁹⁹⁾ **\$120**
Cooked apples, mustard flowers, minerals and hints of stone. Full-bodied Vivid and expansive. Lightness and energy. Eye-opening acidity. Lively citrus notes and white stone fruit. A voluptuous palate with intense flavors of pear, apple and subtle floral and mineral hints. A long, clean finish.
- 234. Montes Purple Angel Apalta Vin. Carmenere 2017, Colchagua Val.** ⁽⁹⁸⁾ **\$100**
Impressive deep purplish-red in color. Outstanding aromas of ripe red and black berries, sweet spices, dark chocolate, and mocha. The palate is structured with soft, ample tannins. The remarkable finish is elegant and intensely complex. Exceptional aging potential. Blend: 92% Carmenere; 8% Petite Verdot

- 55. Austin Hope Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Paso Robles (96) \$120**
Aromas of blueberries, roasted coffee, burnt toffee, cocoa and dried baking spices. Layers of fine dusty tannins with earthy tones, toasted cloves, creamy vanilla and bright red fruit with firm structure.
- 47. Cade Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Howell Mountain (96) \$115**
Lush tannins and bright acidity. Flavors of boysenberry, blueberry pie, red cherry, cola, vanilla, graham cracker, and chocolate truffles. Blend: 87% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Merlot, 4% Malbec, 4% Petit Verdot
- 56. Bella Union by Far Niente Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley (95) \$70**
Luscious aromas of cherry cola, anise, and baking spices. Black cherry, blueberry and other briary fruit flavors guide the wine's bright midpalate, finishing with hints of cocoa and resolved tannins. Blend: 90.3% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4.2% Merlot, 2.5% Malbec, 1.6% Petit Verdot 1.4% Cabernet Franc.
- 25a. Stag's Leap Artemis Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley (94) \$70**
Expressive aromas of dark berries, currants, raspberry sorbet, nutmeg and baking spices. Round tannins and a plush mouthfeel with lingering flavors of dark fruit and subtle oak undertones.
- 9a. Frog's Leap Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Rutherford (750ml) (95) \$70**
Cedar, tobacco, mint and sweet red cherry with a classic, mid-weight feel. Blackcurrant fruit, dense palate, and dusty aromas. Blend: 83% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Cabernet Franc, 8% Merlot
- 9b. Frog's Leap Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Rutherford (375ml) (95) \$40**
Cedar, tobacco, mint and sweet red cherry with a classic, mid-weight feel. Blackcurrant fruit, dense palate, and dusty aromas. Blend: 83% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Cabernet Franc, 8% Merlot
- 48. Galerie Pleinair Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Napa Valley (92) \$65**
Baked berries, prunes and warm black currant cordial notes with baking spices, olives and dried herbs. Medium to full-bodied with baked black berry, velvety tannins finishing on a spicy note.
- 42. Darioush Caravan Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley (92) \$60**
Deep purple black with warm cassis, blueberry preserves and boysenberries with cedar chest, cherry cola and spice cake. Full-bodied, firm. Grainy texture and lively with spicy black berry preserves.
- 54. Austin Hope Cabernet Sauvignon 2018, Paso Robles (95) \$55**
Fresh black currants and cherries with smoke and dried spices. On the palate: blackberry, ripe cherry, vanilla bean and brown butter. Full-bodied and balanced with bright acidity and firm polished tannins.
- 43. Charles Krug Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley (91) \$40**
A rich mélange of cherry, blackberry and black currant flavors. Integrated backdrop of lightly toasted oak leading to a smooth, lingering finish. Blend: 87% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Merlot, 5% Petit Verdot
- 6a. Hess Allomi Cabernet Sauvignon 2018, Napa Valley (90) \$38**
Distinct notes of vanilla and oak spice with classic red fruit flavors set off by currant and blackberry along with moderate, well-integrated tannins showing a round, plush mouthfeel.

52. **Zena Crown Vineyard Slope Pinot Noir 2015, Eola-Amity Hills** ⁽⁹³⁾ **\$100**
Wood smoke, smoked meats, potpourri, black pepper, blackcurrants and black cherries. Medium bodied, sweet and ripe, with earthy layers of turned earth and pipe tobacco. Framed by firm, fine, grainy tannins.
49. **Ken Wright Bonnie Jean Vin. Pinot Noir 2017, Willamette Valley** ⁽⁹³⁾ **\$80**
Floral and spice focused. Juicy and plush with dried blueberry, black cherry, marionberry. Warm spices, nutmeg and cardamom. Raspberry and blueberry flavors, featuring hints of sandalwood and tea.
50. **Ken Wright Canary Hill Vin. Pinot Noir 2018, Eola-Amity Hills** ⁽⁹⁴⁾ **\$70**
Fruit focused. Light tannins and bright acidity. Red and blue fruit- juicy red plum, pie cherry, and marionberry. Harmonious tiers of raspberry, saffras and savory tea with richness and complexity.
51. **Brewer-Clifton Sta. Rita Hills Pinot Noir 2016, Santa Barbara** ⁽⁹⁰⁾ **\$50**
Notes of underbrush, dried raspberry and red currant flavors featuring accents of persimmon and pomegranate. Ripe cherries, candied red fruit, spice and dried herbs. Supple, saline and medium-bodied.
53. **Resonance Willamette Valley Pinot Noir 2018, Oregon** **\$35**
Bright ruby color. Fresh and fruity with red strawberry and raspberry enhanced by subtle floral and spicy aromas. Elegance and harmony describe the palate. Fine tannins with fresh and lengthy acidity.
57. **DAOU Vineyards Central Coast Pinot Noir 2018, Edna Valley** **\$30**
Aromas of cherry, rhubarb and rose petal. Notes of African violet, cloves and toasty oak. Strawberry, cherry and black raspberries. Black olive and truffle. Sweet strawberries, juicy plum, and pine forest.

233. **Catena Zapata Adrianna White Bones Chardonnay 2017, Mendoza** ⁽⁹⁹⁾ **\$120**
Cooked apples, mustard flowers, minerals and hints of stone. Full-bodied, vivid and expansive. Lightness and energy. Eye-opening acidity. Lively citrus notes and white stone fruit. A voluptuous palate with intense flavors of pear, apple and subtle floral and mineral hints. A long, clean finish.
109. **Bouchard Pere & Fils Chassagne-Montrachet 2017, Burgundy** ⁽⁹¹⁾ **\$85**
Intense floral and fruit aromas on the nose. Full-bodied, rich and smooth, with a lingering aftertaste.
110. **Chateau Montelena Chardonnay 2017, Napa Valley** ⁽⁹⁴⁾ **\$60**
Peach, apricot, and honeydew. Citrus blossom and rose water. Fresh pear and cinnamon. Lemon curd with bright acid, green apple, and toast. with a hint of white pepper and plenty of orange zest.
126. **Ashes & Diamonds Blanc No. 3 BDX Blend 2017, Napa Valley** **\$48**
A fully ripe and textured, yet bright, zesty and supremely age-worthy blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Sémillon from two carefully-chosen vineyards in Napa Valley's Oak Knoll District and Yountville.
127. **Knights Bridge Estate Chardonnay 2018, Knights Valley, Sonoma** **\$45**
The nose is complex, forward and pure with hints of stone fruit, grilled almonds, Meyer lemon, and toasted oak. Fresh and lively. Savory spices, ripe peach skin, and a touch of oak.

- 208. Orin Swift Cellars Mercury Head Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa (95) \$130**
Aromatics of ripe raspberry, blackcurrant, cigar box and a hint of fresh sandalwood shavings and Herbs de Provence. Dense and layered on the palate, an immediate note of mixed berry strudel topped with fresh cream, fresh black raspberry and soft tannins transition to a nuanced and concentrated finish.
- 17. Orin Swift Cellars Papillon BDX Blend 2017, Napa Valley (92) \$70**
Rich notes of ripe blackcurrant, blackberry, peppercorn and chaparral supported by a frame of sweet oak.
