# Cask 59

**241. Château Haut-Brion, Pessac-Leognan 2009, Bordeaux (100) \$1,155**

*Extravagant and exotic, but still lively, this is a super-concentrated and elegant wine that's already breathtaking yet has enormous aging potential. Plenty of wet earth and mushroom character alongside the cassis and blackberry aromas. Super-long, perfectly balanced finish. – James Suckling*

**242. Château Latour, Pauillac 2008, Bordeaux (98) \$850**

*Beautiful dark color. An aromatic nose that is fresh and pure. Whilst a little austere, it is rich on the palate yet taught and very elegant. The tannins are soft and supple. A magnificent vintage with an alluring velvetiness accompanied by great depth and body.*

**243. Château Pontet-Canet, Pauillac 2008-2013 Vertical 6pk, Bordeaux \$1,000**

**2008.** *A candidate for the “wine of the vintage,” Pontet-Canet’s 2008 boasts an opaque purple color as well as copious aromas of sweet blueberries, blackberries and black currant fruit intertwined with lead pencil shavings, subtle barbecue smoke and a hint of forest floor. Full-bodied, with fabulous richness, texture, and tremendous freshness, this first-growth-like effort is more developed than the uber-powerful 2010. Give it 5-8 years of cellaring and drink it over the following three decades. Bravo! (RP, 96 pts.)*

**2009.** *Deep garnet in color, the 2009 Pontet-Canet slips sensuously from the glass with opulent scents of crème de cassis, baked plums, and Black Forest cake plus suggestions of Chinese five spice, potpourri, oolong tea and menthol. Full-bodied, rich, spicy and oh-so-decadent in the mouth, it has a fantastically velvety frame and seamless freshness, finishing very long. (RP, 100 pts.)*

**2010.** *The nose explodes with a vast array of black fruit preserves and savory nuances: plum preserves, blackcurrant cordial, black cherry coulis and licorice with wafts of dried lavender, melted chocolate, charcuterie, black olives, truffles, and camphor plus a hint of sandalwood. The full-bodied palate is completely filled with black fruits, exotic spices, and earthy nuances with a firm foundation of ripe, grainy tannins and bold freshness, finishing with epic length and depth. (RP, 100 pts.)*

**2011.** *So smooth, this is a rich, grandiose wine. Although it is full of black currant fruits and spice flavors, the texture is most impressive. Dusty tannins are integrated with juicy fruits seamlessly. The purest fruit flavors are allied to linear tannins in a precise yet generous way. The wine is evolving beautifully. Drink 2020 or after. (WE, 96 pts.)*

**2012.** *Deep garnet in color, the 2012 Pontet-Canet gives up a profound earthy/savory nose, revealing notes of tilled soil, woodsmoke, mossy tree bark, fungi, and bouquet garni with a core of raspberry preserves, boysenberries, and dried cherries plus a hint of warm cassis. Medium-bodied, it has a firm grainy texture and a softly spoken, savory character in the mouth, finishing with lingering oolong tea and dried herbs notes. (RP, 93 pts.)*

**2013.** *Medium to deep garnet colored, the 2013 Pontet-Canet is evolving into tobacco, new leather, and dried mulberries scents with a core of kirsch, baked plums, and cigar box plus a waft of Indian spices. Medium-bodied, elegantly styled and wonderfully refreshing in the mouth, it has a solid line of grainy tannins and loads of mineral sparks on the finish. (WE, 95 pts.)*

**248. Tusk Estates L'Orange BDX Blend 2016, Napa Valley \$800**

*Dark fruit, forest floor, a bit of smoke and char, this showed opulence without being over the top or fruity. Well-structured and delineated, it has great depth of flavor and is full bodied with ultra-fine grained tannins. As per usual with Melka made wines, the texture is near perfection, and the finish lingers for ages. Rare, and awesome. Blend: 57% Cabernet Sauvignon, 29% Cabernet Franc, 14% Petite Verdot.*

*Proprietors Michael Uytensu, Tim Martin and Philippe Melka fell in love with this creation from the 2016 vintage and have patiently been awaiting the appropriate time for its release. A gorgeous Napa Valley blend built on both Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc, the 2016 L'Orange sits well apart from Tusk Cabernet in profile—but stands proudly alongside it in quality. L'Orange is the name they are giving to a wine they produce from time to time when inspiration strikes. The wine may be red or white, may be produced once and never again, or when magic happens may be repeated once in a while but never frequently. The name L'Orange comes from the only accent color in Tusk's black-and-ivory dominated color scheme. Michael, Tim and Philippe associate orange with warmth and creativity, so thought it would be perfect for a rare new addition. 450 bottles produced.*

**201. Hundred Acre Ark Vin. Cab. Sauvignon 2017, Howell Mnt., Napa (100) \$600**

*The 2017 Cabernet Sauvignon Ark Vineyard possesses a deep, profound bouquet of blue-black fruit, cassis, dried violets, Korean spices, dark roasted coffee, and a hint of well-worn leather. Complex, full-bodied, and supremely textured, it keeps coming back with loads of fruit and opulence yet stays perfectly balanced, has silky tannins, smooth edges, and a royal, singular personality.*

**211. Dalla Valle Maya Proprietary Red Blend 2015, Oakville (100) \$580**

*The 2015 Maya shows the great potential of the vintage. Its red-purple hue belies the wine's brightness and fresh aromatic quality, with tones of fresh-cut strawberry, cardamom, and flint. This blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc exhibits a combination of depth, richness, and laser-like focus, delivering a rush of red and black fruit flavors, along with notes of cured meats and salted black licorice. The texture is soft and silky, but at the same time powerful and incredibly lengthy. This vintage of Maya is accessible today, but will absolutely continue to develop, and will last decades in the bottle.*

**261. Futo '5500 Stags Leap' Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley \$525**

*Deep ruby-purple with aromas of black cherry, violets, tar and smoky minerality. The palate unfolds in layers through pure red and blue fruits with distinct mineral freshness. Thrilling fruit and perfume. Ample concentration and structure. Blend: 86% Cabernet Sauvignon, 14% Merlot. 387 cases.*

**260. Futo Oakville Red Wine 2017, Napa Valley \$525**

*Inky with stunning concentration. Graphite, blackberries, cassis, sweet kirsch. Hints of incense, licorice, and spice box. A fabulous purity of blue, red, and black fruits elevated by velvety tannin structure and fresh acidity. Blend: 77% Cabernet Sauvignon, 13% Cabernet Franc, 9% Petit Verdot, 1% Merlot. 529 cases.*

**259. Futo 'OV|SL' Red Blend 2017, Oakville|Stags Leap (97) \$390**

*Deep, sensual, and mysterious. An exotic mélange of blood orange, sage, mint, sweet rose petal, inky red/purplish fruit come together in a wine that is both rich and remarkably light on its feet. Aromatic intensity with fruit generosity. A graphite infused, explosive finish of substantial depth and resonance. Blend: 62% Cabernet Sauvignon, 17% Cabernet Franc, 16% Merlot, 5% Petite Verdot. 546 cases.*

- 214. Lokoya Howell Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley** <sup>(98)</sup> **\$475**  
*The 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon Howell Mountain (100% Cabernet Sauvignon) is deep purple-black in color and offers an incredible perfume of lilacs, black truffles, violets, and menthol over a core of cassis, mulberries, and warm plums plus a waft of tobacco leaf. The palate is full-bodied with very firm, very ripe tannins and oodles of freshness cutting through the earthy layers, finishing very long.*
- 215. Lokoya Spring Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley** <sup>(99)</sup> **\$475**  
*Deep garnet-purple colored and made up of 100% Cabernet Sauvignon, Tantalizing notes of licorice, chocolate box and spearmint over a core of crushed blackcurrants, blackberries, and kirsch plus wafts of roses and fertile loam. Full-bodied, firm and oh-so-minerally in the mouth, it has a solid structure of grainy tannins and seamless freshness, finishing on a lingering earthy note. 825 cases produced.*
- 253. 4 Winds Cabernet Sauvignon 2014-2016 Vertical, Stags Leap Dist.** **\$465**  
*Each of these wines offers a snapshot of the vintage, vineyard, and winemaker Thomas Brown's taste for blending exceptional wine from exceptional fruit. Aromatics of purple and black fruit with fine finished tannins make these elegantly textured wines perfect for the table now or can be cellared for decades.*
- 251. Alpha Omega Era Cabernet Sauvignon 2018, Rutherford** <sup>(99)</sup> **\$400**  
*Silky entrance with soft evolution carried by fine granular tannins, notes of milk chocolate, sour cream, cookie dough, bay leaf, coffee, cedar, grilled meat, camphor, toasted bread, dark cherry, blackberry jam, pomegranate notes. Complex expression with dark fruits, crispy meringue, vanilla beans, underbrush, pencil shavings, almond paste, poire belle-Hélène, pipe tobacco, lavender, violets, lilacs, hyacinth, licorice, leather, hints of paprika. Blend: 92% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Malbec, 3% Petit Verdot.*
- 288-1. Patrimony Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Adelaida District** <sup>(99)</sup> **\$360**  
*Deep purple-colored, the tiny production 2017 Patrimony Cabernet Sauvignon is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon that spent 30 months in new French. This rocking wine has a huge nose of deep black fruits, new leather, unsmoked tobacco, exotic spices, and chocolate. Full-bodied and stunningly concentrated, with awesome tannins, a stacked mid-palate, and just a gorgeous finish, it's a magical and incredible wine.*
- 288-2. Patrimony Caves des Lions BDX 2018, Adelaida District** <sup>(98)</sup> **\$360**  
*Aromas of fresh tobacco leaves and mushroom powder, potpourri, and bitter chocolate, shifting from savory fruit to stony mineral notes in the glass. The cashmere-textured palate offers youthful Morello cherries and spices, kaleidoscopic and persistent. Blend: 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Cabernet Franc.*
- 225. OVID Hexameter BDX Blend 2016, Napa Valley** <sup>(98)</sup> **\$360**  
*Bold Black Forest cake, cassis and redcurrant jelly scents with candied violets, pencil lead, oolong tea and cumin seed with a touch of cigar box. Medium to full-bodied. Red and black fruit beautifully laced with exotic spices and floral fragrances, framed by super ripe, super fine-grained tannins and fantastic freshness, finishing long. Blend: 55% Cabernet Franc, 44% Cabernet Sauvignon, 1% Merlot.*
- 240. Scarecrow M. Étain Cabernet Sauvignon 2018, Rutherford** <sup>(97)</sup> **\$300**  
*Beautiful ripe fruit tones of blueberry jam, fresh warm cherries, and just enough vanilla, spice and sandalwood to add complexity and base notes to the bright fruit components. On the palate, the wine shows very bright and fresh, with the aromatic notes returning as very juicy berry flavors combined with the spice elements. Depth, complexity, and just enough density to prove its age-worthiness but wrapped up in tannins that already show a sense of plushness and generosity. The final blend of estate fruit consisted of 87% Cabernet Sauvignon, 6% Malbec, 4% Merlot and 3% Petit Merlot. 2,315 cases were produced.*

- 202. Joseph Phelps Insignia BDX 2016, Napa Valley** <sup>(99)</sup> **\$300**  
*The 2016 Insignia is fresh and focused on entry with expressive cocoa powder, graphite, and earthy spices. Elegant and complex with a supple, creamy texture and bold tannins, this latest vintage offers luscious ripe plum and blackberry character with hints of roasted coffee and dark cherry throughout the palate to a long, velvety finish. Blend: 84% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Petit Verdot, 3% Malbec, 3% Cabernet Franc.*
- 203. Sinegal Estate Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, St. Helena, Napa** <sup>(99)</sup> **\$275**  
*Aromas of crushed red currants, Chambord, and black tea leaf; enveloped in layers of sweet cigar box and cocoa beans. The full-bodied palate displays flavors of macerated blackberries and blueberries with hints of graphite and dried herbs, leading to a dense tannin structure and long and bright finish. Blend: 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Malbec, 7% Petit Verdot.*
- 204. Staglin Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Rutherford, Napa Valley** <sup>(98)</sup> **\$260**  
*A brûléed, dark fruited marvel that thrills with its texture and layers. A mousse-like quality brings a breath of air and light to the dense, concentrated mouthfeel and softens the abundant underlying tannins that provide a pleasant grip to a powdery, fine-grained mineral driven exit. Blend: 88% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Cabernet Franc, 4% Petit Verdot.*
- 212. Dalla Valle Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley** <sup>(97)</sup> **\$260**  
*Dark and showy with aromatic complexity and effusiveness. Fruit and floral aromas - fresh-cut cherries, blackberries, blueberry pie, and orange blossom - along with earthier elements of dark roast coffee, wet slate, and underbrush. On the palate the wine is powerful, long, and tightly woven, delivering waves of flavor and texture that linger on the finish for nearly a full minute. Opulence, with reserve.*
- 219. Ornellaia BDX Blend 2017, Bolgheri, Tuscany** <sup>(97)</sup> **\$260**  
*The Ornellaia 2017 masterfully interprets what was a particularly warm and sunny year. The intense and dark color heralds a wine of beautiful concentration; the nose, rich and complex, releases scents of ripe red fruits, accompanied by notes of sweet tobacco and vanilla. The taste reveals an Ornellaia of great balance, a combination of firmness and pleasant freshness. Blend: 56% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot, 10% Petit Verdot, 9% Cabernet Franc.*
- 233. CADE Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Howell Mountain** <sup>(98)</sup> **\$230**  
*Aromas of blueberry, blackberry, coco nibs, cran-raspberry, roasted coffee, clove, cinnamon, black pepper, mint, and fruit leather. Velvety texture with lush and prominent tannins and bright acidity. There are flavors of boysenberry, blueberry pie, red cherry, cola, vanilla, graham cracker, and chocolate truffles.*
- 232-2. Catena Zapata Adrianna Vin. River Stones Malbec 2017, Uco Val.** <sup>(100)</sup> **\$220**  
*Incredible aromas of blackberries, hot stones, wet earth, and flowers. Full-bodied across the palate with ultra-fine tannins that melt into the wine. Superb, long finish of subtle fruit terroir-defined subtleties.*
- 226-1. Aloft Cabernet Sauvignon 2015, Howell Mountain** **\$210**  
*The 2015 vintage is reminiscent of a blackberry and blueberry pie with hints of cherry, anise, lightly toasted marshmallow, and vanilla. As the wine continues to open, you will discover flavors of savory cooking spices, such as, oregano, thyme, clove, and nutmeg. A touch of tobacco leaf and aromas of freshly rolled cigar, compliments of our new French oak barrels. On the palate, a touch of sweetness is welcomed by notes of white chocolate and lilac followed by mouthwatering acidity and dynamic, yet lush tannins.*

- 226-2. Aloft Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Howell Mountain** **\$210**  
*The terroir of our Cold Springs Vineyard, nestled atop Howell Mountain, provides the foundation for the palate and aromas of blackberry, blueberry, lavender, anise, cran-apple, and semi-sweet chocolate. The palate is reminiscent of a raspberry Danish glazed with milk chocolate and blueberry pie. Layers of complexity unravel notes of chocolate covered caramel, anise, coffee, black tea leaf, and freshly rolled cigar.*
- 239. Clos Apalta Carmenère BDX 2017, Colchagua Valley** <sup>(100)</sup> **\$200**  
*A stunning nose of crushed berries, fresh flowers, sandalwood, and light vineyard dust. Black olives, too. Very complex. Full-bodied with a beautiful, dense palate of blackberries, chocolate, walnuts, and cigar box. Fantastic length and composure. The tannin just rolls over the palate. Very structured. The most classically structured wine ever from here. Goes on for minutes. Outrageous and so polished. A blend of 48% Carmenère, 26% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot and 1% Petit Verdot. – James Suckling*
- 250a. Castiel Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Howell Mountain** <sup>(95)</sup> **\$195**  
*Hailing entirely from the rocky, elevated slopes of Howell Mountain, this 2017 Castiel Cabernet Sauvignon shows aromas of dark blackberry briars, espresso, earth, and just a very slight base note of sweet vanilla. On the palate, the immense structure of this wine is immediately apparent. Bright fruit combines with a core that shows density and strength. The tannins are plentiful but rounded, adding a sense of juiciness to the finish. 100% Cabernet Sauvignon. Winemaker: Celia Welch. 400 cases.*
- 249a. Corra Winery Cabernet Sauvignon 2018, Napa Valley** <sup>(96)</sup> **\$175**  
*Celia Welch's 2018 Corra Cabernet Sauvignon is a blend taken from choice sites on Pritchard Hill, Rutherford, and Oakville. A dense, sumptuous wine, the Corra Cabernet offers up a compelling mélange of black cherry, chocolate, new leather, and licorice. 100% Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon.*
- 254. Perfect Season Cabernet Sauvignon 2018, Knights Valley** **\$160**  
*A beautiful nose of freshly-baked blackberry tart, juicy dark currants, red plums, cherry compote, and baking spice builds excitement for what's to come. On the palate, the wine is full and broad and includes touches of dusty cocoa, graphite, and dried lavender. The finish is lingering and dominated by dark fruits.*
- 258. Relic 'Artefact' Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley** <sup>(94)</sup> **\$150**  
*Crème de cassis, baked black berries and mulberries with preserved plums, roasted coffee beans, licorice, tar, and tilled soil. Full-bodied, rich, and packed with black fruit and savory layers. A firm, grainy frame with a lovely backbone and a very long finish. 100% Cabernet Sauvignon. 375 cases.*
- 252. 4 Winds Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Stags Leap District** **\$145**  
*Elegant aromas of deep purple and black fruit. Blackcurrant, black cherry, and cranberry mix with hints of savory herb and licorice on a refined mid-palate. The tannins are structured yet supple giving long yet graceful finish. Aromatically expressive with soft contours, generous dark fruit, and plenty of promise.*
- 257. Quill Cabernet Sauvignon Ink Grade Vin. 2012, Howell Mountain** **\$115**  
*Grapes are from the organically certified Ink Grade Vineyard. Flavors of rich cocoa, pencil lead and black fruit. Finishes with refined, well balanced tannins. 100% Cabernet Sauvignon. 250 cases.*

# Red Wine

## Cabernet Sauvignon

- 218a. Quintessa Cabernet Sauvignon 2018, Rutherford** <sup>(99)</sup> **\$230**  
*Intense aromas of cassis, black cherry, and raspberry intermingle with savory notes of sage and thyme. Notes of dark chocolate, graphite and fresh tobacco mingle with the fresh fruit. Precise and dense. Supple tannins play with flavors of black cherry, dark chocolate, and crushed rocks. A perfect balance of fresh acidity followed by bright fruit and minerality at the finish that portends unparalleled aging potential.*
- 205a. Hall, Kathryn Hall Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley** <sup>(96)</sup> **\$195**  
*The 2017 Kathryn Hall is elegantly balanced with aromas of blackberry, freshly turned earth, and a hint of warm, spicy oak. The palate is fruit-forward. Notes of rich cocoa and leather. Layers of black fruit, nutmeg, cassis and brooding earthy notes. Supple, seamless tannin abounds, and the wine finishes with an incredible dark fruit feed-back that lasts several minutes. Blend: 96% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Merlot.*
- 220. Caymus Special Selection Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley** <sup>(95)</sup> **\$195**  
*A blackberry hue, with scents of rich leather, cooked caramel, berries, and forest floor. Youthfully forward on the palate, supple and appealing with rich concentration. Tannins are abundant, yet fine, and persist throughout a layering of textural sensation. The richness of this wine correlates with the fine dust of the Napa Valley soils. Finish expresses oak (French barrel) and Caymus fruit-forward impressions. This wine is tannic, rich, and squared off by signature, Caymus suppleness.*
- 269. Stag's Leap S.L.V. Cabernet Sauvignon 2017, Napa Valley** <sup>(95)</sup> **\$190**  
*Leads with blackcurrants, stewed blackberries, eucalyptus, and cloves. Some dried violets, too. Medium to full-bodied with firm, silky tannins. Very well integrated. Lovely ripe fruit and sweet spices on the finish.*
- 41. Secret Door Cabernet Sauvignon 1X 2014, Napa Valley** <sup>(92)</sup> **\$190**  
*The first Secret Door Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon release. A young cabernet with verve, balance and plenty of currant and blackberry character. Juicy and polished. A beautiful, composed wine.*
- 244. Odette Estate Cabernet Sauvignon 2018, Stag's Leap-Napa Valley** <sup>(96)</sup> **\$175**  
*The 2018 Odette Estate Cabernet Sauvignon, Stags Leap District is full bodied and opaque black in color, revealing Bing cherries, raspberries, blueberries, pencil lead shavings, tobacco, dried herbs, and crushed granite. It's tightly knit core, very fine tannins, and firm structure lead way to the long and persistent finish. Blend: 78% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot, 8% Malbec, 4% Petit Verdot.*
- 216a. PlumpJack Oakville Estate Cabernet 2018, Napa Valley** <sup>(94)</sup> **\$170**  
*Deep garnet-purple color and fragrant notes of Black Forest cake, crème de cassis and wild blueberries with nuances of red roses, Chinese five spice, camphor, and black olive plus a hint of charcoal. Full-bodied, the decadently rich fruit has impressive freshness lifting the palate along with firm, finely grained tannins, finishing long and fragrant. Blend: 88% Cabernet Sauvignon, 7% Malbec and 5% Petit Verdot.*
- 222a. La Jota Howell Mnt. Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley** <sup>(97)</sup> **\$150**  
*A blend of 77% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Cabernet Franc, 7% Malbec, 5% Merlot and 3% Petit Verdot, this wine is deep garnet-purple colored, featuring gregarious crème de cassis, black cherry preserves and baked plums with touches of Indian spices, cigar box and charcuterie. Full, firm and decadently fruited, it has a fantastic foundation and very long, layered, and expressive finish.*



# Red Wine

- 207. Silver Oak Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa Valley** <sup>(94)</sup> **\$147**  
*Notes of cassis, ripe raspberry, toasted coconut, and shiitake mushroom. This wine has a rich entry, depth through the mid-palate, great structure without being heavy and exceptional length on the finish. Fresh cherry flavors balanced with floral notes and a subtle hint of black pepper add a beautiful complexity. Blend: 78.9% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot, 3.5% Cabernet Franc, 2.3% Petit Verdot, 0.3% Malbec.*
- 208. Orin Swift Cellars Mercury Head Cabernet Sauvignon 2016, Napa** <sup>(95)</sup> **\$140**  
*Aromas of ripe raspberry, blackcurrant, cigar box and fresh sandalwood shavings and Herbs de Provence. Dense and layered on the palate, an immediate note of mixed berry strudel topped with fresh cream, fresh black raspberry, and soft tannins akin to baking chocolate transition to a concentrated and nuanced finish.*
- 55. Austin Hope Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2018, Paso Robles** **\$135**

*Offers a core of pure cassis and blackberry fruit, with mouthwatering streaks of graphite and anise. Racy edged, featuring ample grip buried through the finish. Reveals a violet echo for good measure. Textbook.*
83. **Château Les Ormes de Pez, St. Estephe 2016, Bordeaux** <sup>(94)</sup> **\$60**  
*The 2016 Ormes de Pez is deep garnet-purple in color with red and black currants, earth, sage and chargrill on the nose. The palate is medium-bodied, refreshing, and chewy with an herbal lift.*

*Sleek and fresh, with engaging blackberry, plum and black currant compote flavors, with flecks of lilac, incense and black tea sprinkled throughout. Good energy through the finish, with a bright iron note too.*

- 406. Taylor Fladgate Vintage Port, 2017 | Bottle <sup>(100)</sup>** **\$120**  
*The nose is threaded with fine, linear fruit, heady and complex but restrained by a graphite minerality. Signature fragrance of violets. Notes of citrus and wild herbs. Lithe, muscular tannins, firm and grippy on the finish, and ends with a powerful surge of crisp, pure berry fruit.*
- 405. Taylor Fladgate 40 Year Old Tawny Port | By The Glass <sup>(96)</sup>** **\$36**  
*Dried fruit, honey, and a touch of spice. Nutmeg, roasted coffee, and intense nuttiness. The wine is rich, intense, voluptuous. Viscous textures culminate in a finish of incredible length.*
- 404. Taylor Fladgate 30 Year Old Tawny Port | By The Glass <sup>(95)</sup>** **\$22**  
*Deep, old gold color with hints of dried fruit and honey, offsetting the rich nutty aromas. Lush, silky richness with an elegant, slightly austere quality which is quite distinctive. Subtle dried fruit flavors underly, exotic layers of caramel and nuts culminating in an endless finish.*

*Snappy, with plenty of ginger and glazed citrus notes to the dried cherry, plum and raspberry flavors. Features loads of chocolate and spice on the long, lush finish, with hints of white pepper.*
- 401. Croft Fine Tawny Port NV | By The Glass <sup>(92)</sup>** **\$12**  
*Vivid tawny-red color. Nose of ripe mellow fruit with aromas of figs and prunes set off by an attractive woody and spicy character. Smooth and round on the palate, full of rich, jammy flavors.*
- 410. Walton Tawny Port NV, Napa Valley | By The Glass** **\$12**  
*The wine is made in a tawny style, using the 1994 vintage as a base wine. The color is auburn copper, and aromas of maple, orange rind, graham crackers, hazelnut and butterscotch assail the senses. On the palate are flavors of ripe figs, dates, maple syrup and bit-o-honey candy bars. The finish is long and silky with medium sweetness. - 407. Bodegas Grant Amontillado La Garrocha Sherry, By The Glass** **\$8**  
*Very floral with sweet nut aromas. The palate is delicate and rich.*
- 408. Cesar Florido Moscatel Especial Sherry, By The Glass** **\$8**  
*Rich, full, unctuous, and textured with notes of caramel, orange, and raisin. Beautifully balanced and fresh with a gentle acidity, leaving a long clean memory on the palate.*
- 409. El Maestro Sierra Pedro Ximenex Sherry, By The Glass** **\$8**  
*This wine projects its sweet depths of almond flavor through a long finish, leaving a trail of nuttiness and soft acidity that shines during its maturity.*
