





The Texas Skeet Shooters Association

From time to time, I am asked how skeet got started in Texas and what was the early organization of our association. From a box of old minutes that have been kept at the TSSA state office and from memory, I will try to answer these questions.

The Texas Skeet Shooters Association was organized in 1950 for the purpose of promoting the sport of skeet in Texas. The original association was rather loosely formed but as the association grew, it became apparent that a more formal organization was needed.

In 1960, a group of shooters got together and wrote the bylaws for the association that are still used today in their basic structure. Joe Harris of Dallas was one of these writers who contributed a great deal to the final document. In this meeting the Zone structure of organization was proposed but not adopted until 1962. For organizational purposes and to give all areas of the state fair representation, it was proposed that there be:

- Four zones with geographical boundaries.
- The number of directors from each zone would be determined by the shooting population in each zone.
- Directors would be selected from the membership of their zone.
- The President as well as all of the officers of the association would be elected by the board from the board members.

Since the original bylaws were written, there have been revisions made as needed, but the basic bylaws have remained the same. One noted change a few years back was the reduction of zones from four to three due to the lack of members in what was Zone I (West Texas). In the early years of our association the statistical and administrative work was the responsibility of the President and the Board. In 1967, all TSSA records were brought into Dallas and Ruby Welch (Bubba Wood's secretary) took over the secretary / treasurer position and put the clerical end of our association together in a more professional form. In 1985, a computer was purchased but was not put into service until Gene Jackson took over as secretary/treasurer in January 1989, after the retirement of Ruby Welch.

Over the years your association has accomplished many things such as:

1. Acted as "THE MODEL" association for many of the present state associations.

- 2. Promoted skeet shooting and presently has the highest number of active shooters of any state organization in the USA.
- Holds one of the largest state shoots in the USA.
- 4. Consistently has the largest number of high average shooters in the USA.
- 5. Chooses All State Teams in all categories for both open and concurrent events.
- 6. Financially assists clubs, new and old, in expanding facilities.
- 7. Is a major financial contributor to the 4H Foundation shooting program.
- 8. Offers services to member clubs such as mailing labels and current lists of paid members as well as logistical support to the clubs and the individual members.
- 9. Oversees a "Hall of Fame" program initiated in 1983 that is one of the most prestigious awards a skeet shooter can receive.
- 10. Built the finest referee program in the entire world. From 1973 to 1993, Texas has supplied not only its own chief referee but also the chief referee for the NSSA World Shoots. TSSA referees are recognized nationally and internationally as the best. From 1976 through 1994, TSSA referees have run the USA National Championships where the members of the USA National Team are selected. The 1984 Olympics were staffed exclusively by TSSA referees with the exception of one field referee.
- 11. A Life Membership program with 550 Life Members out of an active membership of around 800 members in the association as of May 1, 2023
- 12. Provides an organization that oversees the shoot program and coordinates the shoot schedule for all clubs with the assistance of the members of the executive committee from each zone. Provides the membership with a shoot calendar each year.
- 13. Provides the membership with a sound, well-organized financial base from which to work.

The TSSA is in sound financial condition and is far and away the strongest of all state associations. This has come about due to the dedication and sacrifice of many people over a number of years. To them we say "Thanks" for a job well done and we will do our best to keep it on course.

AWARDS, including medals, purses, and added money are described separately for each event.

PROGRAM CHANGES - TSSA reserves the right to change the program without recourse or protest and reserves the right to refuse any entry or cause the withdrawal of any contestant who annoys, endangers, or interferes in any manner with the proper conduct of this tournament. Any changes deemed necessary will be posted in the registration area.

All reporting position ties and ties involving monies will be shot off. All shoot-offs will be doubles from Stations 3-4-5. NSSA rules will apply. Unlimited gun malfunctions will be allowed during shoot-offs only.

SHOOT-OFFS - HOA Open Championship

Ties for the HOA Open Championship will be shot off using the following format: A regulation round of 25 will be shot using the .410. Total score of the round will apply at the end of the round. If shooters are still tied, the shoot-offs will proceed to stations 3-4-5, doubles. NSSA rules apply.

SHOOT-OFFS. HOA R/U, Third, Classes, & Concurrents

All shoot-offs will be doubles with the .410 Bore from stations 3-4-5. NSSA rules apply. Unlimited gun malfunctions will be allowed during shoot-offs only.

SHOOT-OFFS - Concurrent Events

All reporting position ties and ties involving money or points will be shot off. All shoot-offs will be doubles from Stations 3-4-5. NSSA rules will apply. Unlimited gun malfunctions will be allowed during shoot-offs only.

PAYMENT OF FEES. Cash and check will be accepted for payment of entry fees, along with most major credit cards.

TEAM EVENTS. Ties will be decided by a shoot-off of Doubles at Stations 3-4-5. NSSA rules will apply. Unlimited gun malfunctions will be allowed during shoot-offs only.

RULES, REGULATIONS & PROTESTS. This shoot is registered by the NSSA and their rules will govern except where noted. All participants must have paid their 2023 NSSA dues, and all Texas residents must also pay their TSSA dues before being allowed to compete in this tournament. NSSA rules pertaining to protests will be followed without exception.

LIABILITY. Participants and spectators recognize the exposure to potential injury associated with the shotgun sport and assume all risks of accidents while attending this tournament.

AMMUNITION. NSSA rules are applicable for all ammunition used at this shoot. Ammunition will be available for purchase at the gun club. Hand-loads are permitted.

PRACTICE ROUNDS. Practice will be available Wednesday 12:00 PM to 8:00 PM. No practice is expected to be available during the tournament.

PAYOFFS. Payoffs will be made via mailed check. You are encouraged to pick up your medals before 4:00 PM Sunday at Registration. Watch for signs posted during the shoot stating when you may pick up your awards for a particular event. Awards not picked up before the Sunday deadline will be mailed to the address shown on your registration form. Please, help save our association's money by picking up your awards at the shoot rather than having us ship them to you.

CLASSIFICATION. Current NSSA classification rules will be observed for this tournament. Your class will be determined by your average at your most recent reclassification, but no lower than lowest class gun.

SQUADDING. Four-gun entries will be given preference in scheduling. Shooters participating in less than the entire four-gun program will be scheduled as near their requested time as possible.

SQUADS WILL NOT BE CALLED. It is the shooter's responsibility to be at the correct field on time. Shooters missing their squads will be allowed to join their squad in a subsequent round and finish the event by himself or herself provided, in the opinion of the referee, there is sufficient time for them to complete the event before the next flight. Otherwise, they will be moved to the last flight of the day, if space is available. If space is not available, no refund will be given.

Texas State Skeet Shoot Withdrawal Policy

Shooters wishing to withdraw from any event at the State Shoot must have the approval of the Shoot Chairman before any refund can be made. There will be no refund of fees paid for concurrent events, class purses, or HOA events.

Deposits are necessary to confirm and cover certain shoot overhead expenses. No deposit will be refunded if notice of cancellation is not received at least 15 days prior to the first event (May 18, 2023). TSSA thanks you for your cooperation.



Five classes will be set up according to the Lewis Class Purse rules.* Each class will be shot off to determine a single winner in each class.

There will be Briley prizes to the winner of each class.

*Explanation of How the Lewis Purse Works:

When all the shooting has been completed, the scores are listed in numerical order from the highest to the lowest. They are divided into as many groups as there are classes. For example, if there were 50 entries and 5 classes, there would be 10 scores in each class. The highest score in each class would be the winner.

Since there will often be odd numbers of entries and tie scores on the dividing line between the classes, the following rules have been established:

- 1. Where a short class is necessary, due to odd entry list, the short class or classes shall head the list.
- Where the line of division falls in a number of tie scores, the contestants are assigned to the class in which the majority of the scores appear.
- 3. Where an equal number of tie scores appear on either side of the line, contestants shall be assigned to the head of the lower class.
- 4. Where the original division is changed, due to tie scores, this change shall apply only to the classes directly affected and the original division shall continue in the other classes.

To cite an example, we will take a shoot containing a 100-target program in which there are 5 Lewis classes and 33 contestants. Since the short classes are placed first, there would be 6 shooters in Classes 1 & 2 and 7 shooters in Classes 3, 4 & 5. The final scores are arranged from highest to lowest and the lines drawn in between the classes.

- 1. All shooters are required to belong to the same club and must shoot with the same four (4) team members in all 5-man team events entered. (Shooters do not need to shoot shoulder-to-shoulder in each event but must be entered with the same individuals per 5-man team event). shooters must be classified to enter.
- 2. There will be no limit to the number of teams per club.


